Dear Mr. Shire:

This is to confirm our telephone conversation this date concerning a local freight assignment bulletined to work turnaround between Little Rock, Arkansas and Memphis, Tennessee six days a week. The assignment bulletin specifies that this local will go on duty daily at 1700 hours at Little Rock and that the turning point daily is Memphis, a total of 348 miles. I advised you that a Superintendent's Notice No. 307 had been issued over the signature of J. G. Norwood instructing this local to deadhead "separate" from service to Little Rock daily upon their arrival at Memphis. The superintendent's instructions are obviously aimed at reducing the amount paid to the local freight assignment for the turnaround trip from Memphis to Little Rock.

After discussing this situation, we agreed that Article 4, Section H(2)(b) of the Engineers' Schedule Agreement provides that local freight crews will be paid on the basis of either the bulletined mileage for the day or actual hours, whichever is greater. In the case at hand, the bulletined mileage for the day is approximately 348 miles and that is what the assigned crew is entitled to be paid. Finally, you stated that you would contact the appropriate company officers and advise them of the proper method of payment for this local freight assignment.

Please advise if the foregoing is not an accurate reflection of our conversation.
